Splash hums a little sailing tune.**

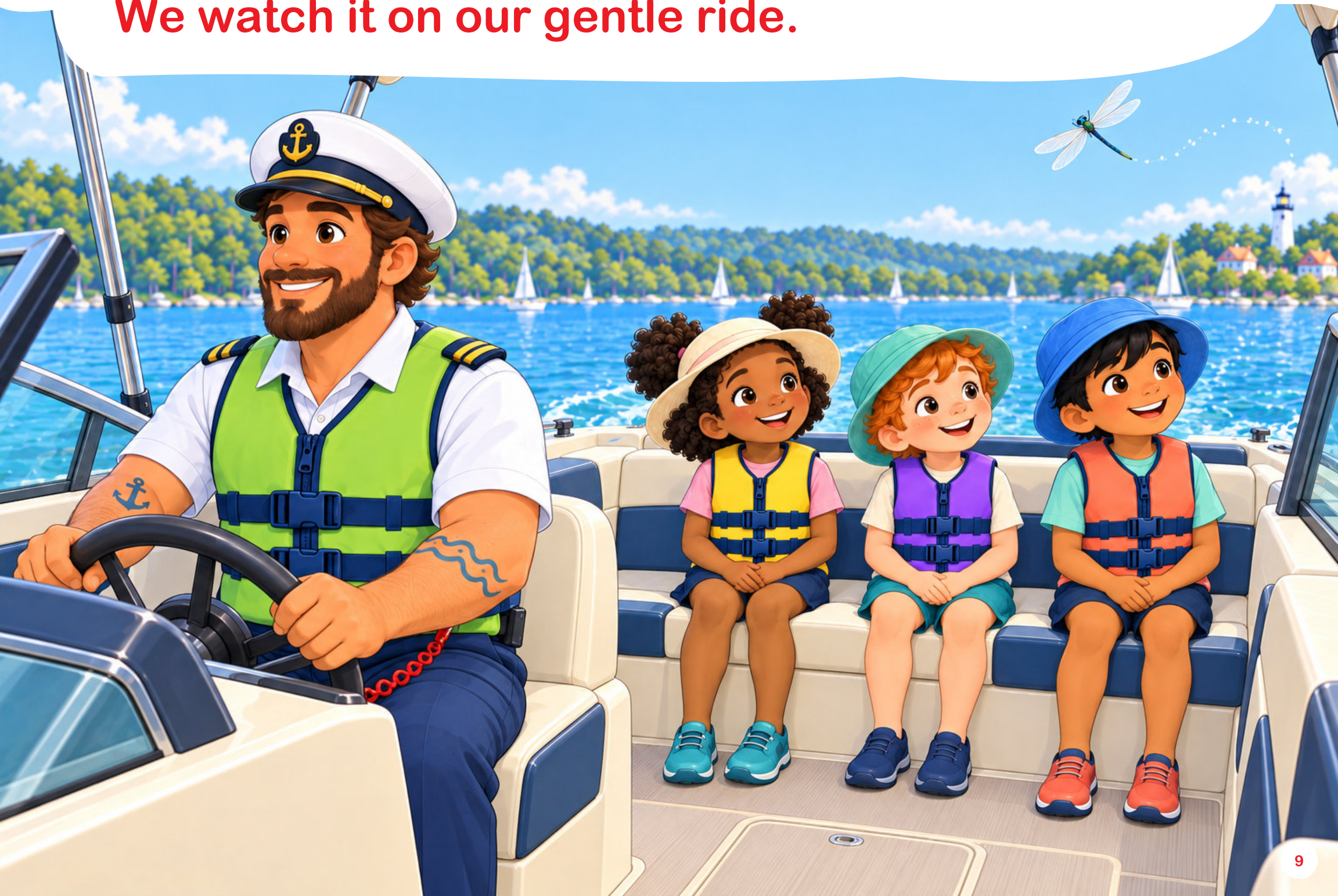


Our boat moves gently through the blue.

Kevin says, "It's time to go."

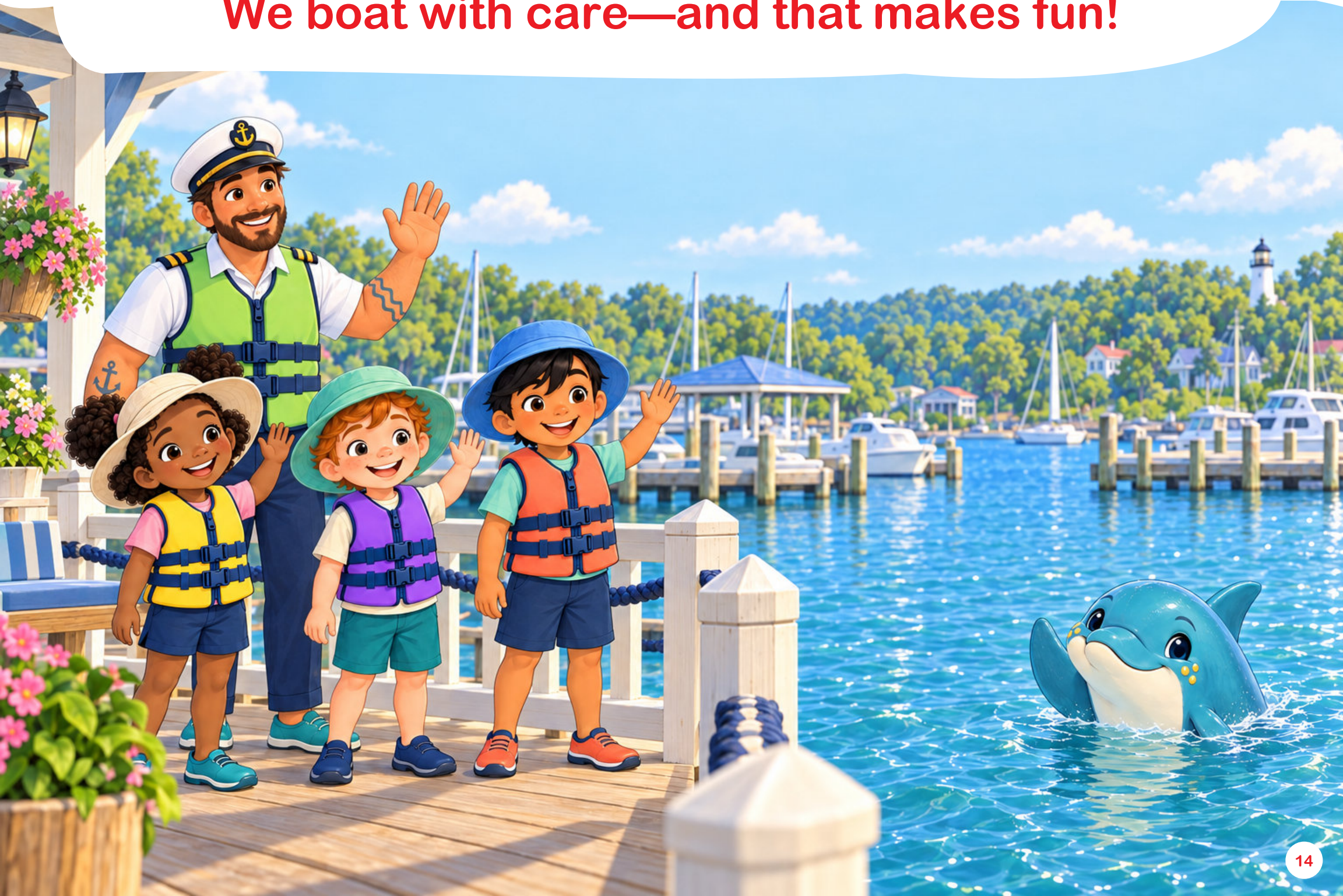
We'll head to shore before the rain.

Then step ashore the careful way.

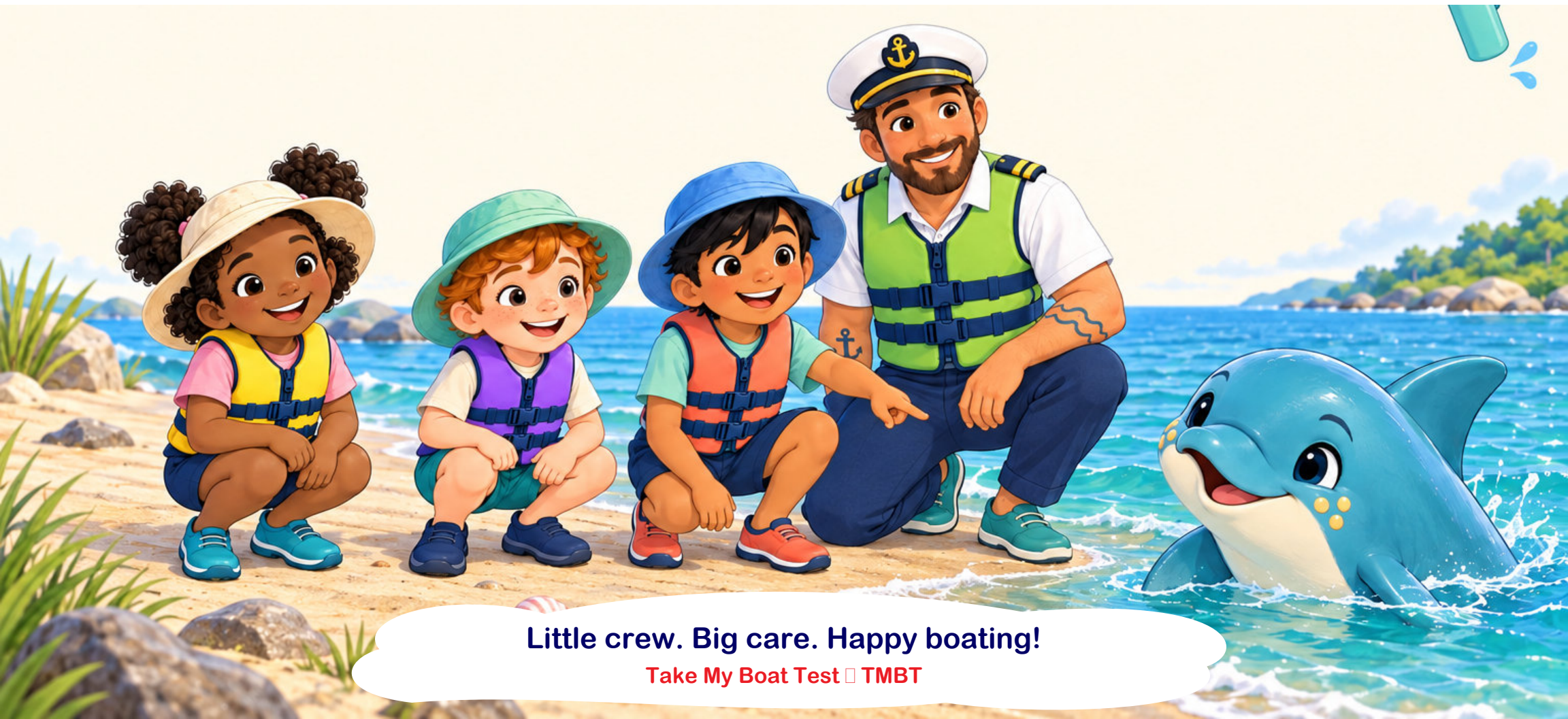


Three happy friends, one captain too,

A ready crew remembers!

- 4 Stay away from the motor and propeller.
- 5 Wear a hat and sunscreen. Drink water.
- 6 Watch the weather; head back before it gets bad.
- 7 Someone needs help? Call a grown-up. Reach or throw—don't go.
- 8 If you end up in the water, stay calm. Stay with a floating boat if safe, and call for help.
